

Redwood Glen Safety Information

Please be aware of the following safety policies requested by Redwood Glen:

1. We ask that you be conscious of fire prevention and conservation of resources.
2. Quiet time is 11 PM to 7 AM.
3. NEVER enter a building that is not assigned for your group.
4. Never leave the developed portion of our facilities (stay on the camp map) unless approved by the guest group leader.
5. Be respectful of other groups.
6. Turn in all weapons, alcohol and drugs to the office.
7. If you brought sports equipment or pets, see Guest Services staff.
8. While on our hiking trails, be on the lookout for poison oak and ticks.
9. The Redwood Glen property is bounded on two sides by steep, dangerous ravines. Be careful!
10. Help us keep the facilities clean – put all trash and recycling in their appropriate receptacles.
11. Redwood Glen is home to lots of wildlife. Doors must be closed tightly (you are responsible for all damage that occurs—including to our buildings). Do not feed the animals, nor chase or throw stones at them (be respectful of them).
12. Please note, Redwood Glen is not responsible for lost or stolen property.
